#111 RUNAROUND BAG - UPDATE JULY 2007

Lazy Girl Designs' Runaround Bag pattern #LGD111 was updated to include some additional tips in July 2007.

If you already own the pattern, keep this page of notes for the next time you make a Runaround Bag.

If you bought the pattern with the red/green floral Runaround Bag on the cover, you have the updated pattern which includes all of this information.

The updates include two tips for the existing pattern. Each tip is outlined below.

STEP 1: FRONT TOP, FRONT BOTTOM AND ZIPPER

AFTER SEWING THE FRONT TOP AND FRONT BOTTOM TO THE ZIPPER.

Topstitch above and below the zipper.

At the end of step 1, stitch on the fabric next to the zipper, catching both layers of fabric in the stitching.

This adds a really nice finishing touch at the zipper. Consider using a decorative stitch or specialty thread to make the most of this detail.

Step 4: Assembly of All Parts

AFTER STITCHING THE PROJECT TOGETHER AND BEFORE TURNING THE PROJECT RIGHT SIDES OUT.

Zig Zag stitch around the seam allowance.

Trim the seam allowances so they are nice and neat. Use a Zig Zag stitch and stitch around all four raw edges of the project to keep the seam allowance from raveling.
